We continue to seek new time-givers to assist in the running of the Besom:

Referral Admin Role (Backup)

(can be done remotely):

Requires approx. 1-2hrs, 1 or 2 afternoons, a week to check the Besom mailbox, to acknowledge new referrals & respond with any queries (i.e. if information is missing)

- To accurately enter new referrals into the referral system.
- To generate client letters from the system & send to Shift leads
- To communicate the number of daily referrals to the teams via WhatsApp.

*These next 2 roles would suit someone already familiar with the warehouse BUT could be someone coming in fresh (and prepared to start with packing initially).*

Back-up / Deputy Shift Leads:

We are looking for someone to take the lead or deputy role in the warehouse, one day a week or as required (8:30 – 1pm), able to phone clients & referrers, with a keen eye for detail & IT skills to manage the mailbox & maintain client records for the morning. Co-ordinating with drivers & overseeing packers. Willing to achieve Level 2 Hygiene certificate (a short online course).

Stock Management/Shopping:

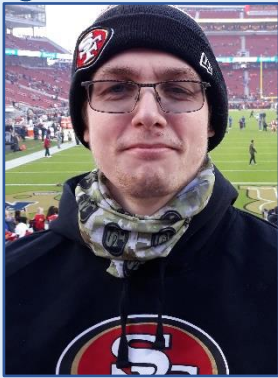
We are looking for someone to oversee the stock in the warehouse, ensure there is always enough for the upcoming shifts, organise shoppers/shopping & take a lead on ensuring the stock is date sorted appropriately and that Teams are aware what stock is to be used next etc. Hours are ad hoc to suit the time-giver, but ideally to include Friday afternoons.

(Thursday Packing Team)



I was first involved with the Besom when I was at the Beacon Church & helped out during lockdown, sorting out the hampers for delivery but had to give it up due to work commitments as I couldn't do both at the same time.

I got involved again in July 2025 as a way of getting back into a working environment. I have been out of work since March 2024 as I was diagnosed with and have now been treated for Aplastic Anaemia.

I was made redundant from my previous job due to organizational changes.

I couldn't ask for a better team to work with on a Thursday & will be looking for a new job this year whilst still helping at the food bank on a Thursday, it's something I look forward to.

Lenten Challenge 2026:

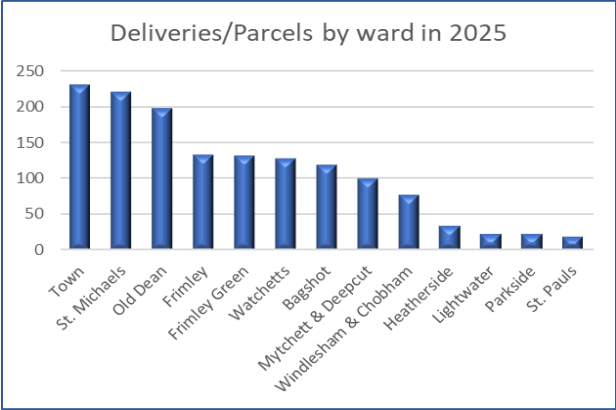
This was so well received in 2025, so many people told us how much they liked it, we decided to do it again. The Calendar will be sent with this Newsletter to the Churches so if you didn't get a copy, please ask your Church Rep, Administrator OR email us.

## Referral Statistics:

In 2025 we delivered :

- Food & non-food parcels to 384 households, (886 unique individuals)
- 235 Households were new to us
- 1,445 Food parcels (that was over 10k days of food and nearly 31k meals).
- We also sent out 169 x Single & 63 x Family 24-hour emergency bags.
- On top of that 63 Household packs!

This is the breakdown of the Wards that we delivered to, with Town, St Michaels and Old Dean having the greatest demand:
